If you have cumulatively spent **28 days or more** in any (or a combination) of the following countries **since May 2014**, you will be required to show evidence of having received a polio vaccination **within the last 12 months**. This may mean you will need to be vaccinated.

This does not apply to infants under 6 weeks of age or to applicants that are pregnant. ALL Refugees and Humanitarian applicants, if nationals of the above countries, are required to provide evidence of vaccination. Vaccination is available at Knightsbridge Doctors at an additional cost of £40. Alternatively, a certificate from a recognised centre (such as an NHS or Government Clinic) may be acceptable. We are advised that failure to provide a certificate confirming polio vaccination within the last 12 months may delay the processing of your visa application.
